Quebec, Canada

God Remembers the French Speaking People of North America

Have you ever felt forgotten by God? Well, imagine an entire province of Canada whose slogan has descended to “The Lord, and everyone else, has forgotten us.” This is what happened to the few faithful Christians surrounding the Quebec City area. In this forested land of short summers and cold, long winters the spiritual climate had turned secular and scarce. But the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob – the God who hears prayers and keeps His word – **He remembers**. Exodus 2:24

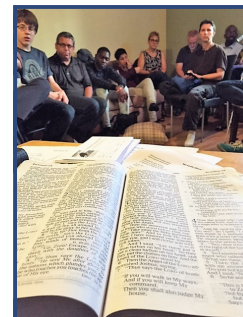
A few of the WOC leaders got a prophetic burden to go to the Quebec City area this spring. We knew no one there. Through prayer and some research, by June, we were on the ground in Quebec City doing encouragement and refreshing meetings for the discouraged believers in the area. We were back in September with instruments, Bible teaching, preaching and worshipping (in French) in any venue that opened – mostly crowded house churches. A fire started to burn again. One of our team’s first utterances was “God has not forgotten you, and He sent us to tell you.” They exploded with tears of joy!

Remembering is important to Québécois, as well as being remembered. Because of so much historical conflict for territorial rights and battles for identity, they carry on their car license plates “Je me souviens”, interpreted as “I remember.” They have a jostling history of French Huguenots (protestants looking for religious freedom) vs. English settlements, Scottish colonialists, and American Indians in the area. After many years, political edicts, and wars they want to retain their identity. But at the same time it is mixed with holding on to past grudges.

As we preached on our highest identity in Christ, to be sons and daughters of Father God, we also emphasized forgiveness. For us to harbor vengeance, grudges and victimization is in direct contradiction to the work of the cross of Christ. As Believers, we are now new creations in Him “... all things are becoming new.” 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore, as we are forgiven, we forgive and forget the grievances of the past against us. It releases “us and them” to move forward.

Six years ago, my wife and I had passed through Quebec City and people in the streets were disinterested in God. Now, they receive prayer in the stores and restaurants, listen to the truth of the Bible and show a new openness. The Holy Spirit has blown out a mind-blinding cloud and changed the spiritual season and time. We are capitalizing on this and simultaneously teaching the people to keep the door open to God and closed to the darkness.

We plan to go back. Families were getting healed. Friends were coming to listen. This is the power of the gospel of the Kingdom of God. Much ministry is needed as the Church prepares for a harvest. Stay posted—God might call you to “Go North.” ➔

Missionaries to Chorrillos, Peru

Steve & Lili are a part of a ministry named "Oikos" which comes from the Greek word for 'extended family' or 'household'. The name captures the expression of a local organic congregation based out of Chorrillos, located south of Peru's capital.

Steve moved to Peru in 2009 from Canada, and two years later joined a handful of other families who had recently launched a "missional community". It was here where he met Lili, with whom he has been specifically evangelizing and pastoring people in their neighborhood since they got married. Since 2014, the Bremners have led over 15 of their neighbors to Christ, and to this day still see several of them in active discipleship in their church.



Lili is overseer of the church's Sunday School ministry.



Steve's main focus has been as one of the teachers in the Oikos Escuela de Ministración (School of Ministry). Each first year enrollment usually has 5 or 6 students who live in a dorm-style apartment and attend classes and work part time, as well as participate in various ministries. Many of the students are from the Shipiboo tribe in the jungles of Pucallpa and speak Spanish as a second language.



Steve is heavily involved in teaching many of the classes in both first and second year from March to December. He also writes books, one of which has been picked up by a major publisher, and he hosts a discussion/interview podcast called **Fire On Your Head**. →
