From the Desk of Dr. M. John Cava

The Church is Not Humpty Dumpty - We Must Arise Together! (It starts with you.)

Taking your city for Christ (or loving your city to Christ) is a common theme among missions. Jesus often rebuked or commended cities because they either rejected or accepted him, and thereby, the people either got spiritual liberty or stayed in their darkness. When there is unity in an area around the knowledge of Christ, great breakthroughs of blessing occur. We see this in the exciting story of Philip going into a Samaritan city in Acts 8:5-8. From a city ruled by sorcery, there became great joy in the city over the gospel. (The famous videos of George Otis, Ir. document some of these city transformations in modern times. See Sentinel Group.) It can happen now.

One of the great keys to a kingdom turnover from darkness to light in a city or town is the revival and unity of the Church of Jesus Christ in that place. Unlike the folk rhyme of Humpty Dumpty in England (He fell, broke and could not be put together again), the Church that is apathetic or fallen has the ability to get up again and come back together because her Head is Jesus Christ, himself. He is the repairer of broken things who makes them better than before. What man calls impossible, God is able to do.

Many years ago in a small village in India, we preached the gospel on the cement pad in front of the town idols. We received death threats by razor from the Hindu priests while ministering. My united team set a perimeter

around the worship, dramas and preaching, but we kept the ministry going (boldness had hit our souls). When we proclaimed the Lordship of Christ above all other gods, and healings broke out among the people, the response changed. Great joy swept over the crowd and even the Hindu priests came to be saved, saying: "This is the one true God above all, the Lord Jesus Christ." I never forgot this moment. Through our united efforts a village came to Christ!

I constantly hear from self-disenfranchised church stragglers, "I was hurt by the church (or they did not recognize my gifting). So, I/my family - are not being a part of anything other than the spiritual Body of Christ." Typically, some leader or department head did something that bugged them. They become antiauthority and unity in their actions and words. What they don't realize is that they are stunting their own maturity of being knit-together in love, and keeping the Church weak and divided in the area (See Ephesians 4).

Let's forgive, heal-up, grow-up, connect-up, pray-up, worship-up, glow-up and go-up to blow-up the gates of hell - and take our cities for Christ. A unified and loving church does what Jesus said in Matthew 16:18b "... I will build My church and the gates of hades will not prevail against it." It starts with you and me. Don't be a Humpty Dumpty. Get up and be a part of winning the nations, person by person, city by city while we have time. Church of Jesus Christ unite for His glory!

Frank and Mary Zychowicz have been serving the people of Malawi since 2013. Malawi is one of the poorest nations in the world, and the majority of Malawi's population live in villages.

Frank and Mary are working with a local couple who pastor one (main) church in the city of Blantyre, and 12 church branches. Their ministry includes community involvement such as feeding people in Blantyre



and villages; some very remote. as well as evangelism and discipleship.



Mary also works with orphans and widows (HIV/AIDS) to help them support and educate themselves.

Frank and Mary's current goal is to create a 'Center of Hope'. They are blessed with the opportunity to purchase two buildings on a large property (see giving instructions).
