If the church is healthy and life-giving, it grows. Over the last months, we have been experiencing first-hand this truth. While endeavoring to build a healthy, life-giving church, we have watched growth, healing and transformation take place in lives of those in the

churches—what a joy to witness this growth period! New Life Church, it's leaders, ministries, and campuses are experiencing God's grace. The Dance Studio, where we currently meet for New Life Oberursel, is now too small. Every week we have visitors walking in the door; many who have been waiting for a church like this to come. In kids ministry, it's grown from 9 kids in Kids Ministry one year ago to 33 kids belonging to just one campus alone! Families are coming because of the weekly children's church, and young couples are coming because we are actively equipping the church in their gifts and callings. Older singles are joining the church to find community and friendship; meanwhile, youth are coming because we are passionate about God. It is an exciting time! We recently had a baptism service as well. Pray that we can strengthen the

has brought, and continue to reach more. We now have a new full time pastor-in-training for the next 2 years who will also launch a church plant. Also, we have a new Missionary family with 4 kids from the USA moving here August 27th, and a new Indonesian German www.strategicglobalimpact.com speaking pastor coming to work 1

with us. Pray for us -for strength, wisdom and great grace! God is raising up a team, so that we can exalt his name here in Germany!

Update from our Network Conference in Tanzania



Last December when I traveled to Tanzania, I was wondering what the Lord wanted to do. Seeing and hearing what the Lord was doing, encouraged me to push in more and expect for further development of our network there. With that, we decided to hold another leadership conference in May. This time we had more than 50 leaders participate. From the first session on, we sensed a deep grace upon the meetings-God's presence was there in a powerful way. As we talked about developing healthy leadership, pastors, and families, an excitement was tangibly mounting. An expectation was rising that we would continue to strengthen the churches in the network AND multiply. We held a round table discussion about how many churches would be planted in the coming days. Today, this family has a beautiful apartment and a beautiful baby girl that they have named "Janine" after the one among others, who has walked with them through this challenging season. During this time, her teenage son found Jesus—Hallelujah! To God be the glory!
