With all of that said here I am and oh how joyful it is to be here.

I arrived to see my good friend the Jackson family and will spend some time ministering in the mountains with other dear friends who I have not seen in a year. Please lift up the time that we will spend trying to reach people with the transforming news and power of the gospel of the Kingdom. I am believing Father for wonderful things and look forward to updating you with a wonderful report.

I appreciate you and all you have done to stand with me as I minister the love and power of our God. I hope and pray that all is well with you and your family as we continue to make the name of Jesus famous all over the world. We go to make a difference!
