The last part of the trip I went to Phoenix, Arizona to my sister's house. It's nice to see Olivia get to know her cousins that are close to her age! They are so sweet together. Isaiah, who is 12, also came back with me and he hadn't been in the States in 6 years. He was so funny to watch observe the "American" way of thinking and doing. He was most amazed by the trucks that everyone drives and how big they are. How amazing your sports and play places are, and how fun American game nights are. On the flip side, he noticed how much junk is sold in American stores and how everything is sweetened (including pizza and pasta!) My brother Alex flew in from Colorado for a few days and it was great for the kids to spend time with their uncle.



We are prepping for the arrival of 4 different families to come the next 3 months and giving them some tours about the martyrs and some background of Christianity in Italy. 2 of them are ministers and then my dad is the last to come the last week of July (it will be his first visit.) Hosting people is a big part of our ministry and one of our great joys! Just for fun with the kids last month, we decided to do a full on count of how many people we hosted (as in, people who slept at our house) over the last 10 years and we stopped at 350. The relationships that we have built from hosting through the years have been very near and dear to our hearts, and we are still in contact with many today!

In June, Sophie has to take her middle school exams to get her middle school diploma. It will be great for her so she can attend our school in 2025 and she will need the proper documentation to attend. Also, Isaiah is finishing his 5th, 6th and 7th grade exams (to homeschool in Italy they are required to take end of year exams.) So, we are busy working with tutors and such these next 2 months in prep for the exams. In June then we head to the North like last year for the Christian American style sports camp that we volunteer in and our kids attend as campers. We have a busy next 3 months also with an outdoor evangelism team coming, personal healing for the nations meetings/counseling going on, and normal church business. To be alive at such a time as this! In the darkness our light shines brightest.

Updates about the school project. We are releasing a video and brochure about the project this month and the needs involved to get it started. Along with announcements about the family coming to direct the school and much more. So be on the lookout for that! On a practical note, Nicolas is starting the search for a job in Florence and we will let that be our guide, when he finds the right job he will give his 4-month notice (required in his contract) and we will start to think more seriously about moving. He will need to still work until he could be potentially hired into the school as an admin/teaching role but that will take some time. Plus, him working a job has been an incredible way to reach the society around and build friendships with Italians.

Thanks again everyone for the hospitality and amazing time we had in the US. We look forward to seeing some of you in the next few months and cherish our relationships! We are blessed to have you in our lives!
