



New Believers and New Churches in Loei Province

After moving our family to Khon Kaen from Loei province at the end of this past January, we felt so torn because there is still so much need for a viable church in that area. We spent much of our time training and encouraging two particular men in Loei to take the Gospel to their own people before we left. Since then, these two men have worked together with another man to see a new church plant take shape in Dan Sai, Loei.

They are now seeing close to 30 people come together to worship Jesus each week in a local hotel. They have adopted a policy of staying outwardly focused and taking the Gospel to the many villages that still have no Gospel light.

They have also started one other house church in a village in Dan Sai district where close to 40 people

meet every Wednesday. This other house church is made up of about 50% believers that have grown cold in their faith and some who have even gone back to Buddhism, drinking, and many other vices. The other 50% is unbelievers that have heard about Jesus, but only recently committed their lives to Him. I am so excited to hear testimonies every week of people being delivered from alcoholism, idolatry, gambling, smoking, and drugs. It is so exciting to hear about what God is doing through these awesome men of God in Dan Sai.

News From Khon Kaen

My time here in Khon Kaen has been so much fun. I have had the privilege of working with Bill and Julie Hughes, long time missionaries in this province. They have done such a spectacular job of training these people that everywhere we go they are constantly sharing the Gospel and praying for sick people.

Recently, on a prayer walk in a new village, we saw amazing things happen as God began to work miracles on the streets. Whenever we would stop to share with one person we would soon have about 10-20 people surrounding us, hanging on every word we shared with them. It was so much fun to sit with a group of Thai people and share with them the hope I have in Jesus.

has been started by one of the new believers. We are hearing testimonies of amazing miracles taking place, leading many to decide to completely surrender to Jesus. A severely broken arm was miraculously set, several women that could not have children are now expecting babies, a man that couldn't walk is now walking, bad backs healed,

and many more wonderful things. One lady told me that she went to every temple, every witchdoctor, every fortune teller, and every shrine she could think of to fix her problems when one of the new believers in the village told her to pray to Jesus and He would help her. She prayed and within days her husband had a job, family problems were resolved, and she felt true peace come into her heart for the first time. I had the wonderful opportunity to baptize her along with the man who previously could not walk, but now is walking because of our wonderful Jesus. Every week I am hearing new testimonies of new believers being baptized, amazing miracles taking place, and lives being radically changed by the power of the Gospel. It is so much fun!! Please pray for us as we continue to reach out into new homes and new villages.
