Update

There has been a lot of shakings that happened last October. We experienced 3 major strong earthquakes ranging from magnitude 6 to 6.6 and a few aftershocks. However, the total number of earthquakes recorded since October 29th is now 2226, with 917 plotted and 161 felt at various intensities according to PHIVOLCS (Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology). We are safe and sound but there are some buildings and establishments in our city and neighbouring cities which collapsed. Also, our fellowmen in other provinces were greatly affected by it where lives were lost, homes, properties were wrecked and even water pipes were damaged.

We gathered pre-loved clothings to be donated. With the help of our friend, Grace and her team, these clothings and relief goods were distributed to the victims in Magpet, Cotabato. We helped purchasing some water containers so they can have potable water. We urge you to pray for our island, Mindanao for protection, provision and for the Lord's Spirit to work mightily especially to the victims who are currently living in tents in the evacuation areas.

Marriage and Parenting Seminar

We attended a marriage enrichment and parenting seminar. It was so encouraging and refreshing to learn, understand and even more love the beauty and challenges of marriage and parenting. We also had our renewal of vows. We were so blessed with our speakers, Pastor Armond Valdez and his wife, Ate Libot (pronounced as ah-teh means older sister).
