For the past 5 years, we have worked with Pastors of different denominations, but now we believe it is time to see them unite and come together. There is so much power in unity! I believe that if we can get a vision of the Lord Jesus Christ and our purpose on this earth, we will then be able to put aside our differences and focus on God's purposes and plans. When God's people come together in unity, I believe that we will see a mighty move of God. I don't know how this is all going to happen, but we are committed to be faithful to each step that God puts before us.

God has already started confirming this vision. We had a Pastor visit from Louisiana who was previously a missionary in south Mexico for 20 years. It will be August 7-9 and will be for the youth of all denominations in and around the city of Juarez. We will be working with many Pastors and Churches of various denominations to bring as many youth as possible to the conference. Our desire is to see the youth set ablaze with the fire of God before returning to school or college and then spark a fire of revival in their schools. God has given me faith to see this accomplished. I believe it is going to be big! Please pray for us as we organize and prepare everything for this conference.
