Christmas Outreaches

Now, for an update on the Christmas Outreaches. We had an amazing season of outreaches! It took us months to get ready for these outreaches and basically all year to gather the gifts that we gave to the children. Then it took us about 4 weeks between December and January to do the outreaches. So, we were ready for a short break this January before we get back to our regular ministry schedule. We went all over Juarez, Mexico to do 25 Christmas Outreaches in some very needy and poor communities. In every outreach, we worked with a local Pastor in that community so that they could continue following up with the families who came. The smallest outreach was about 50 children and the largest outreach about 250 children.

Each outreach we had a drama, games, songs, and a short gospel message. Every outreach there were many who responded to pray with us to receive Jesus. In some of the outreaches, we had time for more personal ministry for those who were sick or just needed prayer. God really moved in amazing ways! I would say that in total with the children and adults that there were at least 5,000 that attended the Christmas Outreaches. So, that is 5,000 who experienced the love of God and heard the message of the Gospel. Praise the Lord! In every outreach, we were able to feed the children a warm meal and in some of the outreaches the adults were also fed. The children also received candy, a stuffed animal or legos, and a hygiene bag. In many of the outreaches we were able to give gifts to the adults. We were also able to give out about 2,500 new children's jackets. Needless to say that the children were very happy! The Pastors were very thankful to see their community blessed. God is just absolutely amazing!

It is such a blessing to see the smiles on the faces of the children as they received their gifts. Then, I can't even try to describe that feeling when a child reached us to give us a big hug and say "Gracias" after they receive their gifts. God really poured out His amazing love on these children! We are just amazed to see how God used so many people to help accomplish these 25 Christmas Outreaches. One ministry donated all the new jackets, a church donated the money to feed all the children, friends in Utah collected 1,000 stuffed animals and many other items, a local thrift store donated probably 2,000 stuffed animals, someone donated about 1,000 bags of legos, many others donated a bag or bags of stuffed animals, and then others donated money that was used to purchase hygiene items and candy. This just shows how that when God's people come together, we can accomplish great things. We are very grateful and thankful for everyone who gave or helped us in any way with the Christmas Outreaches. You were blessed to be a blessing and what a blessing it is to be a blessing! Amen! And now, we begin to prepare and gather for the next Christmas Outreach season. Any gift is always a blessing and helps us tremendously with these Christmas Outreaches.
