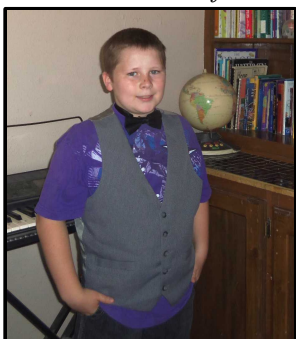

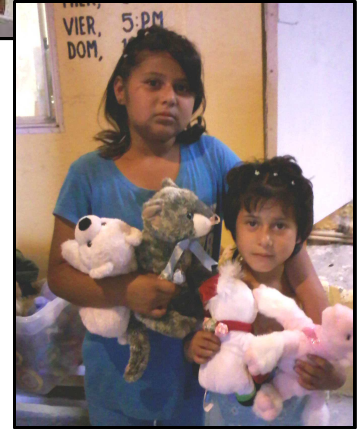


Ministry and Outreaches in Juarez, Mexico and El Paso, Texas

We had some friends (the Armour family) that we have not seen or even talked to in 13 years come to visit us. Jason Armour and I (Randall) went to Bible School together at the Brownsville Revival School of Ministry. When I graduated and moved away, we lost contact with them. They found our contact on the World Outreach Center (our missionary covering) website. They contacted us and came out as a family for a mission's trip and to reconnect with our family. They helped us day after day at God's Storehouse sorting donations. I was able to take them to preach and minister in three different places in Juarez. It was awesome seeing God use them as they ministered to the people. I also took them to El Paso to help Pastor Kelly and Kendra Blanton with an outreach in the neighborhood of their church. We gave out over 100 boxes of donations (clothes, dishes, toys and etc.) that we brought down from God's Storehouse. There were about 300 people that came out. We just loved on the people with the love of Jesus Christ. What a great time that our families had as we worked, ministered and visited together! 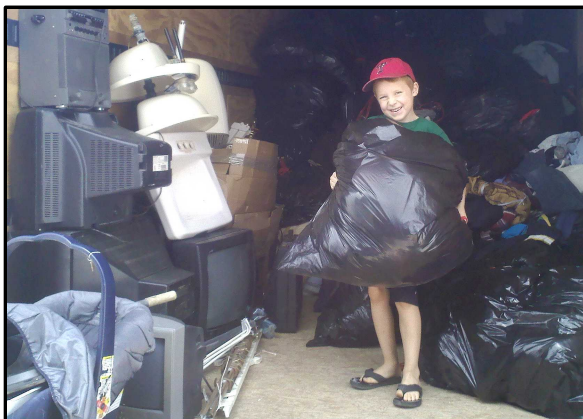

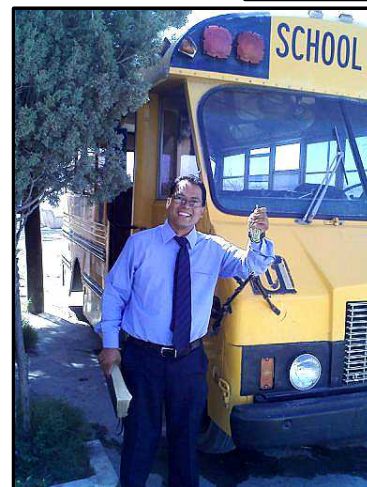

God's Storehouse

There is so much work, as well as, ministry that go on at God's Storehouse. Many of the volunteers that come to help are not Christian. So, we always have the opportunity to witness to them and show the love of Jesus. Every morning, we gather together in a circle to pray and commit our work to the Lord. Sometimes there is a specific need that someone has and we have the opportunity to pray and minister to them. Also, when we go out to pick up the donations we get to shine for Jesus! The donations are coming in so fast that we have a hard time keeping up with it. My family and I all work at God's Storehouse collecting, sorting and packing boxes for Missions. Just in the past two months, I have taken four trailer loads of donations down to Juarez. Each load is nearly 300 boxes of donations (clothes, shoes, toys, dishes, household items, craft items, material, school and office supplies, sheets/towels and etc.). We have had some difficulty with the Mexico border officials. After arguing with them for 1-4 hours, they finally charge us about 130 dollars importation tax. Please pray that the Lord will help us with wisdom and favor with the border officials. These donations were given to about 15 different pastors. These pastors use the donations to minister to the needs of the poor in their churches and the communities around the church. God's Storehouse also supplies boxes of donations to a few other missionaries that are in other countries. We are donating all of the English Bibles that come in to a local missionary couple who box them up and send them to a ministry in Africa. This month God's Storehouse just started helping them with the shipping cost. There is so much that is going at God's Storehouse locally and internationally. The vision is huge, but the workers are few. Please believe God with us for more helpers.

Prayer requests

We are so grateful for each of you that have stood so faithful with us in your prayers and financial support over the past five years. With your help, we have been able to continue the work and ministry that God has called us to do. As always, we covet your ongoing prayers for God's continued guidance, protection and provision.
