We're Pregnant... with a new baby church!

Dear SGI Partners,

We've rounded the corning into 2016 and feel the wind of Heaven, as we are quickly rolling through this year! The last few months have been amazingly busy and fruitful; we've had to do a major adjustment in our ministry and plans due to the influx of refugees into our churches as well as interns into our ministry team! As of right now, we have a steady group of 20-35 refugees from Iran and Afghanistan coming weekly to our Sunday morning Service in Mosaik Oberursel Church as well as about 15 or more that show up to a Monday night Persian house group. Many of these also return through the week for language classes and discipleship. These refugees are coming for many different reasons: language learning, to make a friend, to look into Christianity, to integrate, to worship with other Christians (if they already are Christians) or to look for ways to stay in Germany. For whatever the reason, we welcome them with open arms and love. A few weeks ago, one of them stood up in front of the church and said how nervous he was coming to Germany, but that in our church, he had found a new family! That is exactly what Jesus wants us to be!

And God is growing our ministry team! We have 3 German ministry students from two different Bible colleges who will be joining us this spring to help in various areas of church, refugee, children's, and outreach ministries! These folks are top notch, hard-working, and on fire for God! We are very blessed to have them! They are all interested in being a part of our upcoming church plant in Frankfurt.

Speaking of our church plant—we couldn't be more excited! God is birthing this church and we are along for the ride! He is already assembling a launch team, connecting us in the city, and giving us such favor! We've had unsaved Germans tell us where we should plant and how! The need is so great. We are making plans to begin preparation in April (laying a foundation of prayer and vision setting) and launching the church in November. Pray for us to find a meeting place for the church when the time comes. For now, we need unity on our launch team, wisdom on how to lay a strong foundation, and grace as we continue to prepare the church in Oberursel, where we currently are, for the upcoming changes.

We finally got a car!!! It's taken us over 2 ½ years to raise all the money for a car, but last fall, all the remaining money was donated for the car! We are so grateful for all the one-time donations towards this big purchase.

While the process of getting our Ford Galaxy minivan has taken over a month and some complicated mistakes on the part of the selling company, we are amazed at how much stress is eliminated by having a car and how much more efficiently our days run. We are able to DO many things that were almost impossible without a car. We are already visiting refugees, transporting ministry materials, and are able to be a blessing to so many!

On January 25, 1939, in Matthäus-Kirche Frankfurt, more than 200 pastors came together to discuss how to react to Hitler's demand that the true church include only Germans. On January 25, 2016, God brought together a

group of almost 150 church leaders IN the SAME CHURCH BUILDING to explore how we can ensure that the church in Germany is open to and includes ALL people ("Mono-Multi"cultural church planting)-- from every tongue, nation, tribe and land. A turning point in the history of heaven? We think so!!! From this meeting, Mosaik Church leadership has been invited to host at least 4 conferences this year, all over Germany to catalyze Mono-Multi Cultural church planting and the integration of all nations into the church in Germany – from refugee to international businessman.

Besides our share of winter sicknesses, our children are in a great season of thriving here in Frankfurt. Abbie is reading in German and




English like a champ.
