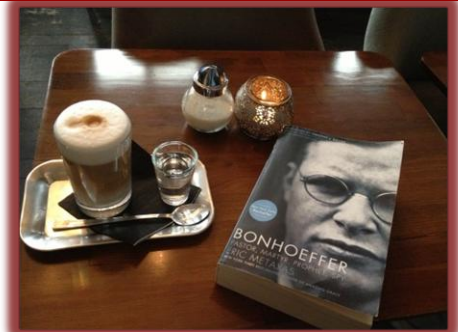
### Dear SGI Partners,

Exciting days are ahead and the Weaver family is about to take the plunge! This has been a season of seeking God as a family for the supernatural leading of the Lord and God has graciously answered us in so many glorious ways. As of a few days ago, we have purchased our one-way airplane tickets for the great Weaver migration to Germany on May 24<sup>th</sup>!

The most recent exploratory trip to Germany was rich in fact-finding, relational development, prayer, and a deepening burden. I, Brian, found myself feeling overwhelmed by the Lord that he would count us worthy to serve Him and these people. As His Children, we are filled with the joy of knowing that we get to join God's mission for Germany, Europe and ultimately His kingdom worldwide.

We are ecstatically jumping back into the rivers of full-time missions – where his supernatural provision, guidance, and calling manifest. One such example of provision is our housing situation. During my two weeks, I had narrowed down our potential landing zones for our move to two cities: Frankfurt and Karlsruhe. However, I was still unsettled as to which location would be the optimum. I whispered a prayer asking God for a fully furnished place that we could settle into for 6 months. The day after my return home to the US I received an email explaining how a ministry couple in Karlsruhe was looking to rent out their *fully-furnished* place for 8 months. It was an immediate answer to my prayer, and Karlsruhe it is, for now. The Weaver 5 will be moving initially to Karlsruhe to begin learning German and acculturate.

Not only did God grant a place, He also opened the door for Abigail to go to school. With kindergarten's not being compulsory, a parent usually has to register their child 6 – 12 months in advance to get a spot for Kindergarten. Are you ready for this? The people who are letting their house to us have a child in Christian kindergarten, and they need someone to take his spot. Not only do we get a house, but Abigail gets a miraculous spot in a Christian German kindergarten. God has made a way!

## Living in the Apostolic Tension

While God is truly a God of order, he equally is a God of the unexpected! The God of the “suddenly” in Acts chapter 2 is still at work. The Holy Spirit was poured out upon the church, and this catapulted both the disciples’ ministry and the church into a new realm of divine order yet chaos--but a godly chaos if you will. It was in order because it was God’s order, not man’s. Growth was accelerating, and miracles were transpiring: the birth of the Acts church was exciting and an adventurous time. With all this excitement, it was simultaneously chaotic by human standards because it was not at all predictable by the natural intellect. In fact, God kept surprising the church by having them stretch their faith, boundaries, areas of work, and relationships (i.e. Peter is sent to the Gentile house of Cornelius!).

**Germany and America needs this kind of Apostolic chaos. It is time for the church to arise in unparalleled power, relentless love, desperate dependency upon the Holy Spirit, and wholehearted devotion to his mission. We must partner with God to see the church advance in grace and truth to make His name famous!!!**

The result of this Apostolic divine tension of order and chaos—strategy and supernatural—was a church that exploded in numbers, influence, strength, unity, and mission. The fire of the Spirit propelled a small group of people into a massive movement in a short amount of time. God does not always work in ways that we see or we would call order, but when we allow for the tension of God-initiated change, we can see God do amazing acts through us, his Church, and in our communities.

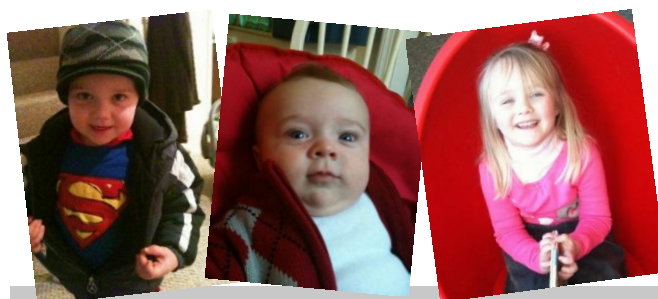
