# Tanzania Update – from December 2016

Brian spent 8 days in Tanzania in December. It was such a blessing connecting with our team there in Moshi and Mtwara. We met with some of the leaders from our network there, and strategized and prayed about how to continue to advance the Gospel and make disciples through church planting in the

coming years. It was a great honor to connect with a church from Ashville, NC who are interested in making a long-term investment in Mtwara. I was able to connect them with the leaders that we trained; it was amazing to see how God works all things together for his purposes!!

### **Bockenheim Vision Nights/Campus Connect**

The Bockenheim (Frankfurt) Church plant launch is set for April! We've already had four Vision Night Meetings for the new site for our New Life Church and have around 25 committed individuals who are helping to launch this new church plant site. Bockenheim is a very important section of Frankfurt, home to the University and many political thinkers. We have been given the opportunity to meet Sunday nights once a month in a facility to encourage entrepreneurship called "Social Impact Lab" (We love that it has the words Social Impact" in the title.) 20-40 women meeting once a month in the evening. Our theme is "Promise." We are learning what it means to be a woman standing on the promises of God (who He is, who I am in Him, and what He has promised us). It has been exciting to see the women growing in God and in relationship with one another. Our last women's breakfast "Frauen

Frühstück" was a wonderful success. It was well attended, delicious and intimate. One new woman said, "I don't even mind coming early to help set up. Just being around you all makes me happy!"



#### Refugee Housing Oberursel

Because of the awesome work and service our church, along with the New Life Team from Virginia Beach, did in the fall of 2016 at the Refugee House in Oberursel, we were featured in a city wide meeting of all of the volunteer services to Refugees. It was quite the honor for us and put our little church on the map as being ones that serve our community. In February, our church New Life was invited back to the Refugee Center to meet with the director on how we can further bless the refugees. 12 people from our church offered their services! We are setting up a schedule of regular help with doctor appointments, translation, kids programs, trade learning, and German language and acculturation. This is a tremendous door open to us. And we are excited about what will come of it in the future!
