# Signs of Grace and Mini-Breakthroughs

For I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me to bring the Gentiles to obedience—by word and deed, by the power of signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God~ Romans 15:18-19b

In these last few months, we have been excited to see a fresh work by the Holy Spirit in Mosaik Oberursel Church; signs of God's intervention and grace are ever-increasing! Wanting to build something that lasts, takes time and significant investment. We are reminded of why it is primarily easier to start a new church, which is still our long-term goal, than it is to attempt to revitalize an existing congregation that is deeply entrenched in its own culture and way of doing things. With that said, God has opened this



strategic church door to us, and we are beginning to see the fruit of the last six months. With only one other evangelical church (English speaking) in this suburb outside of Frankfurt of 45,000 people, this church needed support, renewal, and revitalization. Through God's Spirit, two weeks ago while hosting a healing meeting, 4 people raised their hand to accept Christ. This is just simply amazing since I am not sure when the last time

someone was saved in a service in this way at this church, and this means, to me, that we are beginning to see signs of the work of God deepening. We are sincerely grateful for all that the Lord has done, but we are just beginning to see fruit. Why do we love church planting...and church revitalization ? Because not only do we fulfill the first part of the great commission of making disciples of all nations, but we also get to help with the second part of teaching them to obey the commands of Christ (Matthew 28:20). This is the nitty-gritty of seeing the kingdom come in a nation and transformation: when the cultural values and accepted norms begin to be revolutionized by the truth of the Gospel, the Word, and the work of the Spirit. I have said it before, but I will say it again: Germany does not just need only a few churches, rather, it needs 1000's of churches in the coming days to advance the Gospel throughout this nation and in surrounding nations.
