## Isaiah 54 “Enlarge the place of your tent...”

It was just about 13 months ago when we began preparing to build a team for the launch of our second campus in Frankfurt city. At that point, we had no one on our team for certain for that campus plant except Janine and I. The church revitalization in Oberursel was getting stronger, and a campus pastor was beginning to help me more and more there. We prayed that God would gather a team to birth this new project. Over the course of the year, God has been bringing team members— people who would want to birth this work. At the end of April, we had our first “practice” worship service. The room was charged with expectancy and excitement! We had guests even though we were not trying to invite outsiders to this particular event! About 41 people were there to celebrate with us this next phase of church planting in Germany! The presence of God was so intense and people were so excited to be birthing a new work. During the next 5 months, we will offer training on Sundays once a month to our core team, and we will also continue to offer once-a-month

“practice” worship services. The target for the big public launch is in October. We are asking the Lord for 50 core team members by October to help us launch this work. Meanwhile, we will be reaching out through our small groups, Campus Connect, relationships and our relational networks in the city. It is an exciting time, and we are rejoicing to see that progress is happening! Keep standing with us in prayer as we contend for a movement of life-giving churches to be birthed and for revival in this nation. With many churches in decline, we are celebrating the steps forward and the breakthroughs. It's been amazing and an incredible season! In Oberursel, God continues to add to the work there. We recently baptized an Iranian, who has had a powerful encounter with God through dreams.

## Campus Connect – Outreach to the Goethe University in Frankfurt.

I have carried a burden for two years in my heart and prayed that God would open up a door to the local university of 45,000 students. God has divinely connected us with young lady named Caro, who is a student ministry leader at Goethe U. David Kim (campus pastor for our Frankfurt site) and I have been pouring into a core leadership team over the last couple of months and praying together with them. At the end of April, we had our worship gathering for Campus Connect (Campus for Christ). The core leaders had hoped for 10 students—but 18 showed up! They were so excited to be meeting and connecting with other students, who are also walking out their faith on campus. **Our desire is to unify the disconnected Christians there, and help establish the Christian community on the campus while sharing the love of Christ with other students.** Brian's father Terry Weaver, a microbiologist and missionary, is also meeting with University students answering their scientific questions about creation, the authenticity of the Bible and marrying faith with reason. There seems to be a growing "geistlicher Hunger" (spiritual hunger) in many. We continue to invest in the leaders there and are currently planning for our next worship service.

He is already asking about the possibility to study theology! Our campus pastor, Lenny, is doing a fantastic job helping to bring organization, stability, and community. It is hard to believe that it is only 2-1/2 years ago that we began pastoring the 18 people who were coming regularly.

Between both services on our test worship service day in Frankfurt, there were approximately 93 people ministered to. We are grateful for new souls, steady growth, deepening relationships, more leaders, and continued strength in the vision.
